...IT'S ABOUT TIME



- 1. Observe your playing partners' shots off the tee, in the event an errant tee shot occurs.
- 2. Plan your putt upon arriving to the green. Even if it is not your turn to putt... be ready.
- 3. Putt out if possible rather than marking those 2-3 footers.
- 4. In the event one of you has a lost ball, all others please proceed to your balls and hit away while the lost ball is searched for by the player (3 minutes max please). If within 3 minutes your ball is not found, please take your drop where you last saw it leave play.
- 5. Wave up the group behind you on all par 3's.

USGA Rules Govern All Play except as Modified by Local Rules.

- PROTECTIVE FENCE on #10 is on immovable obstruction.
- PROTECTIVE FENCE on #13 relief two club lengths from post, one stroke penalty.
- DRAINAGE DITCHES: You will be allowed one club length relief from nearest point, no nearer the hole.
- STAKED TREES: Ball may be dropped if stake or tree interferes with stance or swing, nearest relief plus one club length, no nearer the hole.
- HOLE NUMBER 15: The enclosed water pump and the protective fence are man-mode obstructions. Therefore, if your ball lies within or against the fence and it interferes with your stance or swing, you are entitled to relief with no penalty, two club lengths, either side, no nearer the hole.
- OUT OF BOUNDS: As marked on #2, 9, 16, 18 and course boundaries.
